RESOLUTION #03-02

A RESOLUTION SETTING STREET MAINTENANCE FEES

Whereas the City of Bay City (hereinafter referred to as City) has 5 miles of paved roads, a total of 11.3 miles of driveable roads and other undeveloped roads within the City, and

Whereas the City wishes to establish fees to be paid by each user, occupant or property owner within the City as set forth herein, for use of the roads, said fees to be utilized solely for repair and maintenance of the City maintained streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council resolves to establish the following street maintenance fees within the City:

1. \$5.00 per month for each assigned equivalent dwelling unit within the City, whether or not the water meter is active.
2. The City shall be exempt from payment of the monthly street maintenance fee for any equivalent dwelling units billed to the City.
3. The following Equivalent Dwelling Units (EDU's) are assigned:

A. Residential:
Each residential unit containing a kitchen and a toilet \$5.00 per unit

B. Commercial Equivalent Dwelling Units:

- C. Other Commercial and Industrial: To be assigned an EDU in conformance with the sewer user rates set forth above.
